May Board Highlights

The Board approved:

- Oxbow/ Hickson/Bakke (O/H/B) levee alignment
- \$350,000 in USACE funding for USACE design reviews of In-town and O/H/B levees
- \$356,000 for a third Hardship Property purchase

 - HMG developed concept design for levee alignment
- Hardship acquisitions:
 - Continued acquisition process for 3rd and 4th properties
 - Began processing of 5th hardship property

- Continued development of the Agricultural Mitigation Policy
- HMG data analysis of upstream impacts, began development of a master impacted structures database
- Developed Staging Area property impacts timeline
