- Design work continues on Outlet to Reach 4.
- Continuing National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process to address project modifications.
- Preparing for Environmental Assessment (EA) public meeting on June 25.
 - ▶ Fargo Centennial Hall
- Preparing for Northern Landowner design update public meeting on June 26.
 - ▶ Meeting focused on Reach 5 to Outlet
 - ▶ Hold in Harwood



Design Agreement Amendment Number 1

- Design Agreement was executed on September 12, 2011
- Amendment was reviewed by Mississippi River Valley Division and forwarded to Headquarters for approval.
- Estimated time to execute the amendment – August 2013



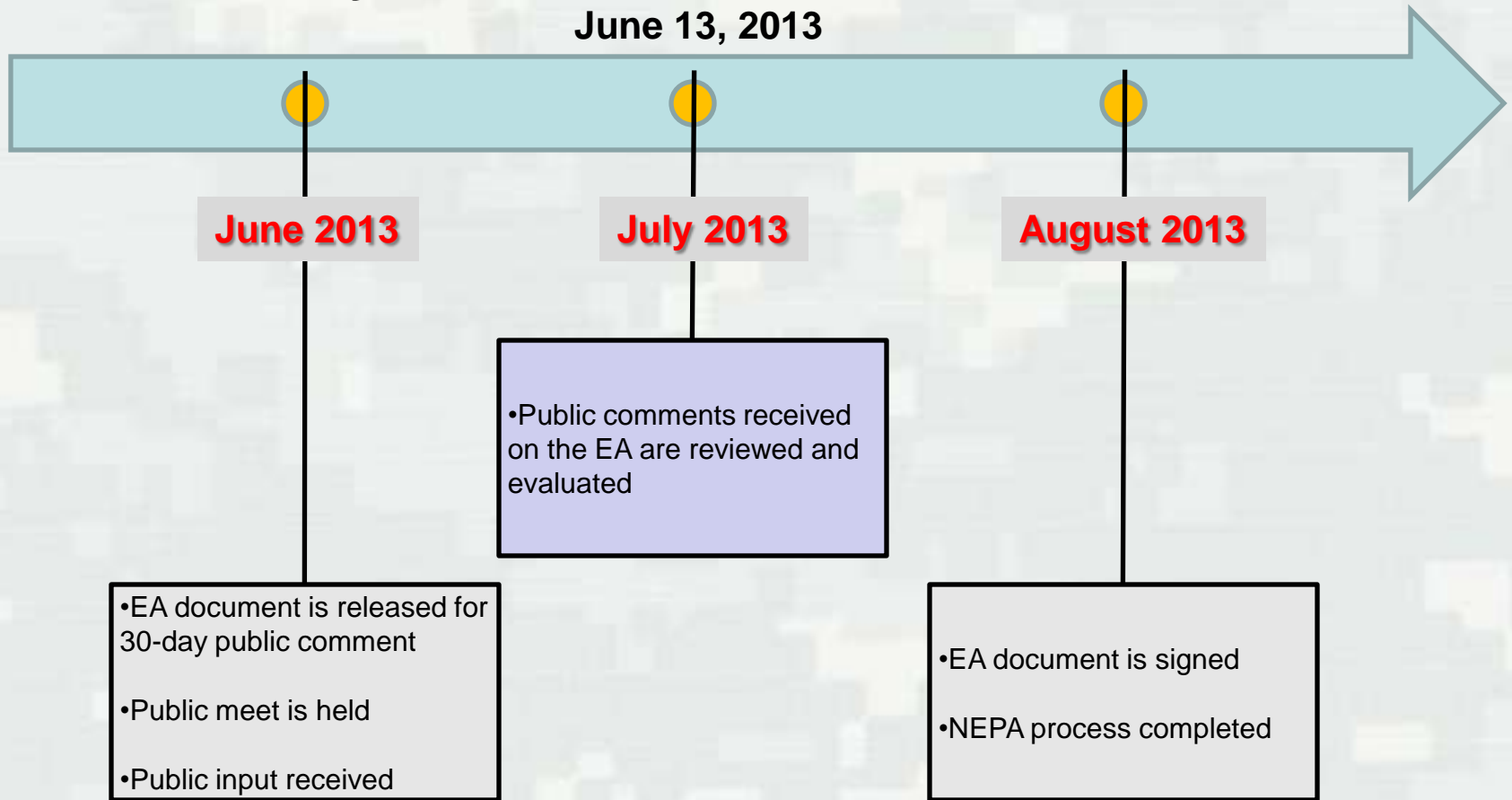
National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) - Path Forward

- November 2012 – May 2013: Corps develops Supplemental Environmental Assessment (EA) document
- June 14, 2013: EA document released, 30-day comment period begins
- June 25, 2013: EA public meeting
- July 15, 2013: EA public review period ends
- August 2013: NEPA process complete and decision is finalized

Federal Funding

- Fiscal year 2013 (Oct 1, 2012 to Sept 30, 2013) —
 - Received \$5 million (President's Budget)
 - Waiting on official notification for work plan.
